With less than a week to go before students are attending the Barton Peveril taster day, we would like to remind you of the key information for the day.

Timetable

The College has emailed students a copy of their timetable. Please remind your child that they must bring this with them on the day.

Arrival

Students need to arrive at college between 8:30 – 9:00am and must make their way to the college field for registration by The Mountbatten School staff. All schools in attendance will have an allocated area on the field to register and collect a coloured lanyard provided by the College. College staff and student ambassadors will be present at the gates to welcome students and guide them to their allocated location.

Departure

Before departure, students need to register again with school staff who will be waiting for them at our allocated location on the field. Departure will be from 2.15pm. Students waiting for collection can wait by the front of reception.

Attendance

If a student is unable to attend the college taster day, please inform our Attendance Office as soon as possible so that the information can be forwarded to the college.

Food and drink

Students can use the College's catering facilities during breaks and lunch and are encouraged to bring cash with them to purchase food and drinks.
