Dear Parents and Carers

You may already be aware that due to Storm Ciarán a major incident has been declared in Southampton and nearby coastal areas. This is therefore likely to affect a large number of our students and hinder the safety of their journeys to and from school. The Local Authority has advised schools to close due to these risks.

Sadly, along with Romsey School and our other primaries, we have had to take the decision to close the school on Thursday 2nd November for all students. Unless you hear otherwise, the school will be open as normal on Friday 3rd November.

Staff will set learning activities on Google Classroom for their classes on Thursday.
