Year 9 - The Globe, London - Schools' Production of 'Macbeth'

We are offering a trip to Year 9 students on Monday, 21 March to the Globe Theatre in London. This is a chance to see a wonderful production of 'Macbeth' that has been adapted especially for schools. Students will study the play in full during the summer term and the trip will aid students' understanding of the context and performance of Shakespeare's plays which will support their studies at GCSE.

We will be leaving school at 10.00am to travel to the Globe for a 2.00pm performance. The performance will last until 3.45pm when we will return to school. Our expected time of return is 7.00-7.30pm (students will advise you at the earliest opportunity of any changes owing to traffic).

Students will need to bring with them a substantial packed lunch and also enough drinks to last throughout the day. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them.

Students will be required to wear uniform on this occasion and we would also ask that students bring a suitable warm waterproof coat. Students will be representing the school on this trip so the highest standards of behaviour and uniform will be expected. We would also ask that all students bring with them a face mask.

The cost of the trip is £34.00. If your child receives Pupil Premium funding, we would ask for a contribution towards the cost of this trip of £5.00. If you would like your child to attend, please register your interest before **Friday**, **11 February** by completing this <u>registration Google Form</u>.

Should there be insufficient interest, the trip will not run. We do have a limited number of places allocated to us and if the trip is oversubscribed, the school will apply the oversubscription criteria outlined in our trips policy, available on our web site. If your child is successful in acquiring a place on the trip, you will be contacted to make payment via our website to secure their place. By paying for your child to take part on this trip you are also giving permission for them to travel.
