Year 7 Geography Fieldwork - Lulworth Cove, June 2022

To reinforce current classwork in Geography, a field trip has been organised to Lulworth Cove in Dorset. We will be studying the coastal features of the area and assessing how tourism is sustainably managed there. The work will be of a practical nature including surveying beaches, sketching cliffs and conducting tourist surveys. We will also take the fairly strenuous walk over to Durdle Door.

Considering cliff falls in recent years, pre-visit inspections of the area have been carried out by staff. New footpaths are in place to avoid any parts of the coastline deemed hazardous by the authorities. The adult to student ratio will be 1:15.

CLOTHING

Not school uniform. This fieldwork may involve getting wet and muddy. A warm, waterproof jacket is essential along with walking boots, wellingtons or old trainers. T-shirt, shorts, sun lotion and a hat will also be required if the weather is hot. Please make sure students have a change of shoes and maybe an old towel in case conditions are wet and muddy and **please supply hand sanitiser**. Whilst we would advise mask wearing on the coach, mask wearing is not mandatory. Your child's bag will be left on the coach at all times, so you they will not need to carry it anywhere on the day.

Please supply a substantial packed lunch and plenty to drink. If your child is entitled to a free school lunch, this will be provided for them. There will be no opportunity to purchase food or drink at lunchtime but, depending on time, students may have a chance to purchase an ice cream or souvenir, just before we leave.
