## **Year 11 Prom Points**

As you will know, students have to reach 250 Prom Points in order to be invited to this year's Prom. Prom Points are earned through excellent work, monitoring and attitude and are lost through demerits and interventions. This target is perfectly achievable – almost 90 students have made the target already and over half of the year group are only 50 points away, or less. Prom Points are updated each week and shared with students by their tutor.

We wrote to you recently to inform you and your child of how they were progressing towards their 250-point target and mentioned that we were intending for it to be one of several letters we would be sending. We are pleased to tell you that instead, we are now able to use epraise to display and communicate this information. This means you can be easily and fully up to date with your child's Prom Point total at any moment.

To view your child's current total, log in to epraise and choose 'my children' from the menu. From the resulting page, choose 'assessment' and then 'around school' from the subjects.
