# Year 10 Eastleigh College Taster Day 2023

Your child has chosen to attend the Eastleigh College Taster Day on **Tuesday 18 July.** It is now time for them to select their taster sessions. Students will take part in two taster sessions and are able to choose from over 16 curriculum subjects, led by industry professionals.

We would like to draw your attention to some important information:

#### **School Uniform**

Students are not required to wear school uniform but are expected to wear sensible, comfortable clothes which they don't mind getting messy. Please see subject-specific clothing requirements as below:

# Hair and beauty:

Flat, closed toe shoes to comply with health and safety regulations.

# Automotive, carpentry, electrical, engineering, plumbing and refrigeration:

Sturdy shoes / boots, rather than trainers.

### Catering and hospitality:

Students need to tie their hair back if they have long hair.

# Gym instructing and personal fitness:

Students should bring loose fitting clothing with them that allow them to move freely; for example: leggings, tracksuit bottoms and a t-shirt or PE kit.
