Getting ready for September

We want all of our students to make a really positive start to the Autumn Term. Consequently, we ask that you go through the attached 'Standards Checklist' with your child to ensure that their return to school in September runs smoothly.

As you will know from a previous communication in June, changes have been made to the uniform in line with new government guidance regarding branded items. We continue to have two suppliers for our branded items - Skoolkit and Direct4logos (based in Romsey).
